Veterans Square is the proposed new construction of a 30 unit 100% supportive housing project targeting households earning between 30% to 50% AMI in Old Town Pittsburgh. The project will consist of a 3 story Type V-A building with a unit mix of 28 one-bedrooms and 2 two-bedroom apartments. One two-bedroom apartment will be designated for on-site management.

The City of Pittsburgh Housing Authority will provide 29-project based vouchers. Nineteen of the units will serve homeless veterans through the HUD-VASH program. The remaining ten units will be set aside for homeless residents with serious mental illness through HCD's No Place Like Home program. The ten NPLH units are restricted at 30% AMI.

The project will provide 5 parking spaces onsite and 25 additional parking spaces in a 12,500

SF gated parking lot across the street from the project. Project amenities include laundry rooms, community room, a spacious 4,186 SF outdoor courtyard with seating areas and planter boxes for community gardening.

SAHA is securing the last piece of financing and anticipates starting construction in 2020 with estimated completion in 2021.
